

Fear God

Ecclesiastes 3:12-15

In this passage, Solomon has a word for us, as well as some truths about God...

Solomon tells us to do three things:

- 1. Rejoice
- 2. Do good
- 3. Eat, drink, and enjoy

Solomon gives five truths about God:

- 1. Whatever God does is forever
- 2. Nothing can be added or taken away from God or His ways
- 3. God should be feared
- 4. God is unchanging
- 5. God is working out His purposes
