Samaritan's Purse, Operation Heal Our Patriots

Each Sunday evening throughout the summer, Samaritan's Purse aircraft touch down on the gravel runway at Samaritan Lodge Alaska to the sights and sounds of a flag-waving crowd. In one way, it marks the end of a journey for weary military couples, but it's the beginning of something, too.

Couples come to Alaska looking for a way to fix broken relationships and marriages on the brink. Often they feel far from God. But as they step away from daily life and distractions, many couples find hope awakening again as they go through six days of chaplain-led, Biblically based marriage enrichment training. They also connect with other couples who have faced a lot of the same struggles. Many across the country pray that they will find both rest and a new start with God and each other.
